Players - April 30 age date Rosters - Name, birthday, uniform Callups/rostered 12u kids - can not pitch

Season - Regular season start week of 4/24 thru either week beginning 6/5 (12 games) or 6/12 (14 games).

Makeup games

Playoffs start 6/12 or 6/19 (cap classic 6/22-25) Semis and Finals week of 6/26

Game Day - May start with 8, 9th spot is an out. If you start with 9 you can finish with 8 but it is an out

Forfeits - forfeiting team pays for the umpire

Game Balls - Wilson 1074 or equivalent

Equipment - Catchers wear cups, batters, runners full helmets with ear guards

Bats - 2 3/4 max, 8.5 max drop. USA, BBCOR. Wood is permitted. USSSA is not

Home team - Responsible for field, umpires, communication. Also reports the score - text to Joe 412-596-6712

Lineups - 9, 10, entire lineup, anything in between. Once your order is set it is set.

Sliding - head first is legal, illegal slides are ejection

Games - goal is 2 hours - communicate with both teams and umpire beforehand Extra inning if time and darkness permits

5 run limit in the first 6 innings. Dead on the 5th run unless the ball has traveled over the fence. Unlimited last inning. Playoffs there is no run limit in any inning

10 run rule after 5, 15 run rule after 4. Includes playoffs.

Pitching- 7 innings max per day. 10 in a week. Week starts Monday. 4 innings or more requires 40 hours rest (from the start of the first game)

Standings - 2 points for a win, 1 point for a loss. 1.5 points for a tie Proposal - Forfeit loss 0 points
If a game is not played, no points awarded

Discipline/illegal players/ejections
