




Field Diagram

# 6U Game

## Notes

- 2 Teams: Home vs. Visitor
- Offensive Scoring Bucket Is placed by 1st base in 1Bs inning. It moves to foul ground behind 3rd base in 2Bs and 3Bs innings. It is located behind the team bench in HR inning.
- Defensive Scoring Bucket moves each inning behind the destination base for that inning.

**NOTE:** In 2Bs and 3Bs innings, all runners exit the field on the 3rd base side of the diamond.



**Visitor coach or volunteer:**  
Hands each batter a scoring coin as they cross 1st base. Visitor (batting team) player drops scoring coin in bucket after completing base running assignment

**Home coach:**  
Receives throws at 1st base. If the defense gets an out, the coach should hand a 1-pt. coin to their player who is fielding at 1st base and let him/her drop it into their scoring bucket

**Volunteer**  
**NOTE:** Keep batting lineup organized. Also, for safety, make sure each runner runs *behind* the home plate area (as shown) while returning to the batting line.

Top of 1st inning  
1Bs-inning shown
